E. Superintendent Report

 Report on Construction Progress - Bid packages for the new high school building project are now available. Over 30 contractors have expressed interest in bidding. Bids are scheduled to be due on January 10, 2013, although the date may be changed to January 15 to allow for more bid development time

- 2. Report on Building Security Progress Building Security Equipment for the Elementary School Buildings are on order. Mr. Kunde will be installing the equipment (camera, buzzer, monitor system) as it becomes available. Currently, it is expected that most of the equipment will be installed over Christmas vacation.
- 3. Brief Update on Becoming a Member of St. Clair RDS/CTE Approval of Wesclin as a member of the St. Clair RDS/CTE Cooperative is expected on 12/19/2012. Wesclin's membership would be effective 7/1/2013.
- 4. Change in Petition Deadline The deadline date for acceptance of School Board Election Petitions is 5:00 p.m. on December 26, 2012. This is a change from December 24, 2012; 5:00 p.m. The state legislature changed the date so that school offices could be closed on Christmas Eve. The Wesclin Business office will be closed on Christmas Eve, but will be open on December 26th from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
- 5. Teacher Institute Options for the Wesclin Staff Wesclin is requesting of the Regional Supt. Of Schools, the opportunity to provide inservice training at Wesclin on the February Tri-County Institute Day. If approved, training would include training in CPR, Mental Health Disorders, and First Aid. Training would be limited to 20 to 40 staff members.
- 6. Report by Budget Committee The Budget Committee met earlier this month to review possible ways to increase revenue and decrease expenditures for next fiscal year. Dr. Fridley reported that the Committee recommends the Board:
 - a. Identify ways to reduce the current deficit spending in the Education Fund (approximately \$620,000 in FY13) by \$200,000 to \$250,000 dollars in FY14.
 - b. Over the next three years take action to eliminate deficit spending in the Education Fund.

It was noted that passage of a tax referendum of 50 cents per hundred dollars of assessed evaluation would increase Education Fund tax revenue by approximately \$620,000.

II. Public Comments:

Several parents asked questions regarding safety of students in the district buildings including:

- A. Are there intruder drills held? Yes
- B. What will the soon-to-be installed security system include? The system will include a camera/buzzer system linked to the building office. People wishing to enter the billing will have call the office and identify themselves. Once buzzed in, they will be required to sign in at the office.
- C. Will additional security measures be installed? When? Yes, evaluation of the security of the school buildings will continue to be done. The new high school will have enhanced security. Options at the current Jr/Sr High School are currently being evaluated, but new security systems are not immediately expected.

Parents thanked the Board for hearing their concerns and for approving new security measures at the elementary schools.
