## Joint Annual Conference

## <u>Investments</u>

The district currently has \$2,110,000 in an 11-month CD at FCB Banks that will mature on September 11th. Mrs. Filyaw shared that at that time, the funds will need to be reinvested, and plans to speak to banks prior to maturity to secure another CD for a period of 1-2 years, depending on the interest rate.

## Trenton TIF Plan

Mrs. Filyaw stated that she spoke with Mayor Brandmeyer about the possibility of an Intergovernmental agreement that would allocate a percentage of funds to the school district for a TIF-permitted project. He shared at this time, the City of Trenton could not commit to such an arrangement.
